Minimum Academic and English entry requirements from Taylors Auckland Foundation Year to gain guaranteed entry to degree programme for students applying for admission into the university in 2012. The entry requirements listed in the table below apply to international students only. Please note however that the Taylors Auckland Foundation Year (TAFY) is approved by the New Zealand Vice Chancellors Committee as a university entrance qualification for NZ citizens and permanent residents.
